




## THE GOSPEL

## Message from the Bishop

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Last Thursday, we celebrated the Feast of the Ascension, which holds great significance in our Christian faith. It is the completion of Jesus' earthly mission.

In our Creed, we profess our belief that Jesus "ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father." This Ascension is Jesus' triumphant return to the heavenly dwellings and to the Father, where He prepares a place for all the faithful. This is a source of hope, assuring us that we will one day share in His boundless joy and eternal glory.

For forty days following His resurrection, the Risen Lord appeared to His disciples, speaking to them about the Kingdom of God and preparing them for the next phase of their journey. Throughout these forty days of Easter, we have walked alongside the disciples, reflecting on the Lord's apparitions in our weekly Gospel readings.

The Son of God came among us not only to share our life on earth but also to invite us to dwell with Him in the Heavenly

Kingdom. He went ahead to prepare a place for us in His Father's house (Jn 14:2), so that we may abide with Him and never be left as orphans in this world. As Jesus separates Himself from His disciples, He gives them a roadmap for their earthly lives: "Go, make disciples of all the nations...and teach them to observe all that I have commanded you" (Matt 28: 19-20).

The Feast of the Ascension, occurring forty days after the Resurrection, signifies the completion of Jesus' earthly life. It took place on the Mount of Olives, bearing witness to Jesus' continued presence among us in a renewed way. He transcends the confines of a specific place, entering all space and time, intimately close to each and every individual.

Although Jesus has ascended and fulfilled His mission, He has not left us alone. Soon, the Feast of Pentecost will arrive, when the Holy Spirit will descend upon us, making His dwelling within us and providing us with guidance. Jesus remains with us through the Eucharist, enabling us to experience a profound union with Him even here on earth.

Beloved, the Ascension is a reminder that God introduces us to an incredible hope—the promise of sharing in His glory through the bond of love. And this hope is not a distant dream but a present reality in Christ Jesus, who has gone before us. May our earthly pilgrimage remain always focussed on our eternal home - heaven!

## "As I have loved you"

Can we be honest when asking ourselves: "Are we walking in love, just as Christ loved us and offered Himself to the Father as an oblation for us?" This is a very personal question, especially for us who have dedicated our lives to the service of God and to His Church.

Even though Jesus showed many signs and wonders in his mission on earth, still there were those who did not believe Him. It should be no surprise to us then, in whatever ministry we are involved, when we are faced with the same doubts and rejections. Where does our encouragement and consolation come from, to endure the trials we face today? Our consolation and our model is Jesus, the Christ. We have no other choice but to walk in love, if we are truly to follow his commandment to "love one another."

We do not fear, if we place ourselves at the foot of His Cross, with Mary our Mother. This is how John the Beloved was able to endure the sight of the crucified Christ, even after all the other disciples had deserted Jesus on Calvary. This is how we endure our own crosses every day, standing by the side of Mary, the Mother of God. Our Blessed Mother paid no heed to the praises or to the condemnations of men. She imitated the Son whom she herself taught and nurtured and directed. In her humility, we are made strong. In her obedience, we follow the Will of the Father.

The Word of God reminds us that there is no greater love than the love of God for His people, and that our hearts must not focus on the winning of praises for ourselves, but our hearts must perceive, and believe in the mission that Christ has left for us. We have been called, and we have been chosen to do the Will of the Father in making disciples of all nations. The Church has given us wonderful role models to encourage and to inspire us on this seemingly impossible

path of unconditional love - saints who have walked in the footsteps of Christ, who still walk among us even today, following the footsteps of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph.

"Love one another, as I have loved you" - this is what He asked of us, and this is the example we must give to others, for they will know that we are Christians by our love. We cannot fear when we love, for God is Love. We are His children, the heirs to His Kingdom...let us live lives worthy of such an inheritance. Let us speak with words of love, think with thoughts of love, and act with hearts of love. Let us walk in love, giving glory and thanks to God the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit







اسببه. على الرغم أن وصية المحبة قديمة موجودة في العهد القديم: "أَجببُ الربَّ على الرغم أن وصية المحبة قديمة موجودة في العهد القديم: "أَجببُ الربَّ الملك بكلّ قلبك وبكلّ قوّتك. وأحبب قريبك حبّك لنفسك" (تثنية ١: ٥؛ متى ٢٠: ٣٠-٩٠). إلاّ أن الجديد الذي أعطاه يسوع في تعليمه عن المحبة:" ...أن تحبّوا بعضكم بعضاً كما أنا أحببتكم" هذا هو الجديد وهذه هي المفارقة. كما أنا أحببتكم أي الحب حتى الصليب، الحبّ حتى الفداء. حُبّ بلا حدود وبلا شروط: إنه ملء الحب الإلهي، "لأنه هكذا أحب الله العالم".... تأتي هذه الوصية في معرض كلام الربّ عن تمجيده الله، وفي مناسبة تأسيس سرَّي المران والكهنوت، كسرَّي المحبة الظاهرة في ذبيحته ووليمة جسده ودمه، والمطلوبة في محبّة خدمة الكاهن ورسالته. وكما يمجّد المسيحُ الآب بواسطة الصليب، هكذا يمجِّد المسيحي الله والمسيح بواسطة المحبة.

(ا يوع ٢٠٠) ويقول القديس يوحنا الصليب " أن مَنْ لا يحبّ قريبه، فهو يكره الله" إذا حُبّ القريب في العهد الجديد هو جوهر الإيمان. ويؤكد يسوع على هذا بقوله: "بهذا يعرف الجميع أنكم تلاميذي إن كان فيكم حُب بعضكم لبعض". من هنا تصبح هذه المحبة "هويّة" الإنسان المسيحي، فبالمحبة تُعرف وبدونها لسنا بمسيحيين. فالمسيحيّون مؤتمنون على حضارة المحبّة، بحكم المعمودية والميرون والقربان. ولذا تسمّى "أسرار التكوين

المسيحي". محبة الله تفاجئنا دائما والله أبانا يحبنا كثيرًا وهو جاهز لمسامحتنا دائما ٧٠ مرة سبع مرات، نعم هو ينتظرنا دائما ممتلئًا بالمحبة وعلّمنا أن نمارس أعمال الخير والمحبة تجاه الآخرين، فلنسأله أن يساعدنا اليوم كي نعرف طريق المحبة.

في النهاية تبقى المحبة فضيلة سامية بسمو الله لأن الله محبة وفي مساء الحياة، سنُحاسَب كلنا على هذه المحبة (متى ٢٥: ٣١-٣١).
