Message from the Bishop

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

On this third Sunday of the Season of Pentecost, we are reminded of the profound message contained within the Gospel of St John. In these verses, Jesus speaks to us, saying, "Those who love me will keep my word, and my Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them" (John 14:23). These words reveal to us the path to becoming the dwelling place of God.

Love is the central theme that echoes throughout this passage, and indeed, throughout the entire Bible. In this Season, we are reminded that the Holy Spirit guides us in understanding that love is the essence of God Himself. To love is to keep the teachings of the Lord, embracing both the vertical and horizontal dimensions of love.

The vertical dimension of love pertains to our relationship with God. Jesus instructs us to "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind." This call to wholeheartedly love our Creator reminds us of the depth of intimacy we can experience with God when we open our hearts to Him. By surrendering ourselves completely to Him, we allow



God's love to flow through us and find its true dwelling place within our souls.

The horizontal dimension of love pertains to our relationships with our fellow human beings. Jesus teaches, "Love your neighbour as yourself." This command encompasses all forms of love, whether it be the love shared within families, friendships, communities, or even towards those we perceive as enemies. It is through our love for others that we bear witness to the transformative power of God's love in our lives.

God, in His divine plan, created us as social beings, meant to live in harmony and unity with one another. Through our relationships and interactions, we are given the opportunity to contribute positively to society and humanity as a whole. When we respond to God's immense love by accepting His word and keeping it, we create a space within ourselves for Him to dwell. In this dwelling, we find the peace and love of Christ, radiating outwards and transforming the world around us.

Let us remember that our calling as Christians is to embrace the love that God has poured into our hearts and to share it abundantly with others. By keeping the word of the Lord and living according to His teachings, we allow God to make His home within us, and in turn, we become instruments of His love in the world.

May the love of God dwell within us, guiding our every thought, word, and action. And may His peace, which surpasses all understanding, be with us always. Amen.

"Know God – know Peace"

To know God requires us to know His Commandments, and obey them, thereby growing in virtue and grace. This can only be achieved if we have love in our hearts – the love of God. For, as it is written, "no eye has seen, nor ear heard, nor the human heart conceived, what God has prepared for those who love him." No matter what we are experiencing in life – trials, struggles, doubts, division – only God can fill us with a peace of heart that the world can never fill. How? If we love Him and keep His Commandments, Jesus promised that He will make our hearts His dwelling place, and the Blessed Trinity will abide in us if we abide in Him. Jesus never breaks a promise!

Personally, I don't need any reassurance other than a promise from the Sacred Heart of Jesus, no matter what it may cost me. Finding peace amidst turmoil, sickness, suffering, poverty, is not impossible if we unite our pain with the merits of Christ. He may not choose to take away our pain, but He does so much more – He enters into our pain with us. Just as we unite our offerings with those of Jesus, He too unites Himself with us. He wants us to follow Him by taking up our cross daily, and denying ourselves daily. He did not abandon us to do this alone. In fact, He sent the Holy Spirit to guide us and teach us how to follow Him. That's not all – He left His Body, His Blood, His Soul, and His Divinity, as a "prisoner of love" in every consecrated Holy Eucharist, waiting to give Himself freely to us at every Sacrifice of the Mass. This is LOVE in action; this is the source of our peace and strength, the source and summit of our entire faith.

How can we possibly compare what the world has to offer, with what Christ has promised? So, what is He asking of us in order to claim that

love and peace? Perhaps forming good habits for life... mercifulness, patience, kindness, generosity, prayerfulness. What is peace, after all? Is it being free of cares, having all that we need, without troubles or fatigue? Or, is peace the ability to overcome the trials that embrace one's life and to rise above them, persevering in Faith, Hope, and Love?

Corpus Christi – the Body of Christ – remains with us, as long as we remain in Him. May the Peace of His Most Sacred Heart continue to reign in our hearts!

ANSWER

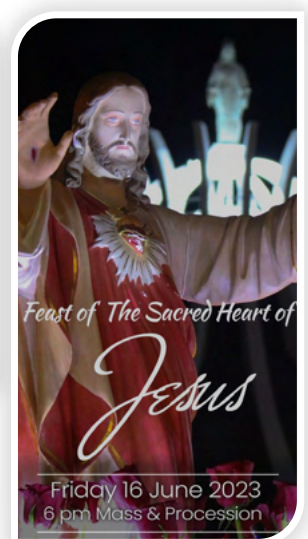

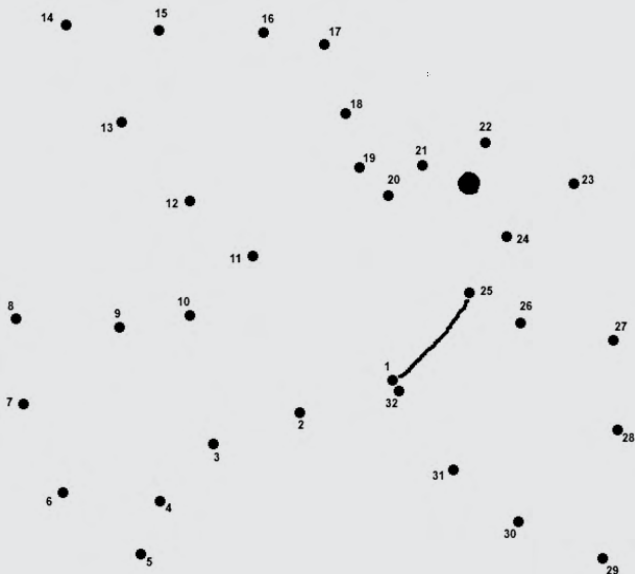
