Message from the Bishop

On this Sunday, 9 July 2023, we will gather to celebrate this milestone and offer a prayer of thanksgiving to the Lord for His abundant blessings upon our Church in this land.

I express my deepest appreciation to all the dedicated individuals who have generously contributed their time, talent, and resources to assist with the renovation of our new Maronite parish. We, Maronites of Australia, celebrate this significant milestone together, honouring our heritage, and looking forward to our future with hope and faith. May the sound of prayers and the smell of incense fill St Charbel's Church for generations to come and may God's blessings always be upon our community, inspiring us to shine as beacons of faith, love, and compassion in every corner of this blessed land.

Feast of the Blessed Massabki Brothers

On Monday 10 July, the Church celebrates the feast of the Blessed Massabki Brothers: Francis, Abdel Mohti, and Raphael, sons of Nehme Massabki, who were martyred in July 1860 in Damascus, Syria.

Francis, a generous and successful man, worked in the silk trade, and his integrity and hard work earned him a great fortune. His popularity and kindness extended beyond the borders of Syria, and he was beloved even in distant villages in Lebanon. Abdel Mohti, a man of solitude, was dedicated to his family and his teaching. He instilled in his students a deep faith and true piety. Raphael, a humble man with a childlike devotion to the Virgin Mary, sought her intercession in all matters.

In 1860, Ahmed Pasha ruled Syria. He was a tyrant who massacred Christians. On the 9th of July, he launched an attack against the Christians of Damascus. The three brothers sought refuge in the Franciscan convent. The soldiers of Ahmed Pasha entered the convent and seized the Superior who promised to show them the place where the treasure was hidden. He led them to the church, opened the tabernacle and consumed all the consecrated hosts. He was slaughtered on the altar.

Francis was praying on his knees before the statue of the Virgin. Ahmed's soldiers recognised him. They approached him and said to him: "Sheikh Abdallah sent us to save you from death, you, your brothers, your families and all those who depend on you, on condition that you deny your faith and convert to Islam." Francis' calm answer is one that echoes through history: "Sheikh Abdallah can take the money that I lent him, he can also take my life but, my faith, I will never deny; I am a Maronite Christian and, for the faith of Christ, I will die." He was slaughtered in the chapel.

Similarly, Abdel Mohti and Raphael refused to betray Christ and were brutally murdered. The three martyred brothers were buried alongside the Franciscan priests, all martyrs of their faith.

Sixty years later, their heroic deaths were not forgotten and Pope Pius XI proclaimed their beatification on October 7, 1926.

Today, we celebrate the memory of these holy brothers who chose martyrdom over renouncing their faith. Their sacrifice continues to inspire us to hold firmly to our beliefs, even in the face of adversity. As we honour their memory, let us also pray for all Christians facing persecution worldwide, that they may find the same steadfastness and courage to stand firm in their faith.

"Disciples for Christ"

Over the past 30 years I have tried to live out my calling as a lay missionary, to spread the Good News, whether it be through media or through personal encounters and witnessing. When I think of the different avenues by which I have access to resources and formation materials, I am always grateful for my Spiritual Fathers, Brothers, and Sisters who have guided me and other souls along the way. Without learning the Teachings of our Catholic faith it would be impossible to follow the path of Christ as He commanded. Saint Jerome, a Father and Doctor of the Catholic Church, insisted that "Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ." Generations before us may be excused of such ignorance - for example, my grandmother in Lebanon who had no formal education - but for those of us who know how to read and write, there is no excuse.

Christ sends out all the baptised, filled with the gifts of the Holy Spirit, to enlighten the world. In the words of the late Mother Angelica, foundress of the global Catholic television network EWTN, **"I cannot bring Christ to my neighbour and to the world if I have not first given him to my family"**. She reminds me of the importance of discipleship in this day and age, reminding us that we are all "missionaries" on this earth and each of us has a distinct role in going forth to make disciples of all nations, starting with our own families. Living a life that is exemplary, i.e. Christ-like, speaks louder than a thousand words. Teaching our children to pray and have a relationship with the Blessed Trinity is fundamental in a Catholic home. Thankfully, our Lebanese/Maronite culture has formed a majority of our families in this way, and our homes are a good example of "the domestic church" as they should be. But, let's not rest in this alone - God sees more than outward appearances, and He expects to see our hearts transformed as well.

We are blessed to have many outlets in our Maronite parishes that provide faith formation, whether it be on a regular weekly basis, or courses provided within our facilities. It's vital that we take these opportunities to grow in our faith. We cannot give what we do not have, so I can't begin to encourage another soul in living a life of grace if I have no knowledge of what this means. After more than 30 years of teaching and evangelising, I am still learning more each day. Listening to the Readings and Gospel in Mass is the first step, and reflecting on the message that scripture places into our hearts is the next step. Now, go forth and make disciples of all nations with Faith, Hope and Love.

الشهداء الموارنة المسابكيين

فرنسيس وعبد المعطي ورفائيل الذين جادوا بحياتهم لأجل
إيمانهم بالمسيح في دمشق سنة ١٨٦٠.

كانوا معروفين بتقواهم ووفرة غناهم وكرم اخلاقهم وحسن
معاملتهم وعطفهم على الفقراء والمحتاجين. وهذه خلاصة
استشهادهم: عام ١٨٦٠، يوم ثار المسلمون في دمشق والدروز
في جنوبي لبنان على المسيحيين، لجأ شهداؤنا، مع عدد كبير
من المسيحيين، إلى دير الرهبان الفرنسيين في دمشق،
عندما اضرم المسلمون النار في حيّ المسيحيين فدخل
اللاجئون مع الرهبان الى الكنيسة يصلّون واعترفوا وتناولوا.

وظل فرنسيس وحده في الكنيسة، جاثياً امام تمثال الّام
الحرينة، يصلي. وبعد نصف الليل دخل الدير عنوة، جمهور من
الرعا، مدججين بالسلاح. فذعر اللاجئون ولاذ بعضهم بالفرار
واختبأ البعض. وهرع الباقون الى الكنيسة ليحتموا بها. فأخذ
اولئك الرعا يصرخون: "اين فرنسيس مسابكي؟ اينا نطلب
فرنسيس". فدنا فرنسيس منهم، غير هياب، قائلاً لهم: "انا
فرنسيس مسابكي ماذا تطلبون؟" فأجابوه: جئنا ننقذك
وذويك بشرط ان تجحدوا الدين المسيحي وتعتنقوا الاسلام
والا فانكم تهلكون جميعكم. فأجابهم فرنسيس: "انا
لمسيحيون وعلى دين المسيح نموت. اننا نحن معشر
المسيحيين لا نخاف الذين يقتلون الجسد، كما قال الرب
يسوع". ثم التفت الى اخويه وقال لهما: "تشجعا واثبتا في
الإيمان، لأن اكليل الظفر معدّ في السماء لمن يثبت إلى
المنتهى". فأعلنا، فورا، ايمانهما بالرب يسوع بهذه الكلمات:
"انا مسيحيون ونريد ان نحيا ونموت مسيحيين".

فانهال المضطهدون، اذ ذاك عليهم، بالضرب بعصيتهم
وخناجرهم وفؤوسهم، فأسلموا ارواحهم الطاهرة بيد الله،
مؤثرين الموت على الكفر فنالوا اكليل الشهادة. وكان ذلك في
اليوم العاشر من تموز من السنة المذكورة آنفا.

وعَيْنَ الرَّبِّ اثْنَيْنِ وَسَبْعِينَ تَلَمِيذًا آخَرِينَ لِيُشِرُوا بِاسْمِهِ، لِأَنَّ الْحِصَادَ كَثِيرٌ، أَمَّا الْفَعْلَةُ فَقَلِيلُونَ.

ما زالَ الرَّبُّ يَسُوعُ يُرْسِلُ الْمَسِيحِيِّينَ كُلَّهُمْ بِحُكْمِ الْمَعْمُودِيَّةِ وَالْمَيُورُونِ، وَأَيْضًا بَعْضَهُمْ بِحُكْمِ الدَّرَجَةِ الْمُقَدَّسَةِ، وَبَعْضَهُمْ بِحُكْمِ النُّزُورِ الرِّهَابِيَّةِ، وَنَحْنُ مِنْ هَؤُلَاءِ جَمِيعًا. يَرْسِلُنَا لِغَايَةٍ مُثَلَّةٍ: إِعْلَانُ سِرِّ الْمَسِيحِ لِجَمِيعِ النَّاسِ، تَحْقِيقُ اللِّقَاءِ الشَّخْصِيِّ بِهِ أَفْرَادًا وَجَمَاعَةً وَإِحْلَالُ سَلَامِهِ فِي كُلِّ مَدِينَةٍ وَمَوْضِعٍ.

واليوم نواصل خط التلاميذ الاثني عشر والسبعين الذين أرسلهم الرب يسوع، "كما أرسله الآب" (يو ٢٠: ٢١). يرسلنا مثلهم، جملًا بين الذناب، إلى عالمنا حيث الحصاد كثير على كل المستويات لنشهد لقيم الانجيل ولنطبع بها شؤون وواقعات هذا الزمن. فكل إنسان مُعَمَّدٌ عليه أن يعتبر نفسه رسول سلام لهذه القضية، قضية خلاص الإنسان، ويكون مثلًا على الأقل لإرشاد الجميع ليسوع الذي هو الطريق والحق والحياة!

إذًا نحن المسيحيين، في حالة إرسال دائم، ووجودنا رسالة. رسالتنا ترقى إلى عهد المسيح والرسول، إلى ألفي سنة. واليوم في خضم الصعوبات والمحن يجدد المسيح الرب هذا الإرسال، ويقول لنا، كما قال للإثنين والسبعين: "ها أنا أُرسلُكم".

لا تحملوا للطريق شيئًا لا خبزًا ولا طعامًا ولا نقودًا، ولا تلبسوا قميصين... لداء عديدة لأن المطلوب واحد، ألا نتعلّق بأي شيء آخر غير يسوع. لأن المهموم بهموم العالم، والمهموم بمصلحته الشخصية، سوف يساوم على الحقيقة، سوف يساوم على يسوع ...

فالهدف الأساس من كل رسالة، هو تغيير القلب فيتحول من حجر إلى لحم (٢ قو ٣: ٣)، إلى قلب إنسان يتكل على الرب فيعطى ثمرًا. وعلى خدام العهد الجديد أن ينطلقوا بقلب منفتح من دون ضمانات أو يحمل سوى الكلمة وقوة الروح. ينطلقون دون أن يسلموا على أحد في الطريق إن الوقت ليس وقت زيارات وأحاديث وثرثرات بل هو وقت الرب. وقت تقديسي وبشارة، وإيمان ورجاء ومحبة.
