# THE GOSPEL

Now the birth of Jesus the Messiah took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been engaged to Joseph, but before they lived together, she was found to be with child from the Holy Spirit. Her husband Joseph, being a righteous man and unwilling to expose her to public disgrace, planned to dismiss her quietly. But just when he had resolved to do this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife, for the child conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. She will bear a son, and you are to name him Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins." All this took place to fulfil what had been spoken by the Lord through the prophet: "Look, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel," which means, "God is with us." When Joseph awoke from sleep, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded him; he took Mary as his wife, but had no marital relations with her and she had borne a son; and he named him Jesus. # Message from the Bishop

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This Sunday of the Season of the Birth of Our Lord, our Maronite Church invites us to reflect on the Revelation to Saint Joseph. This revelation, intricately intertwined with the prophecies of Isaiah that we read in our first reading (Isaiah 7:10-15), sheds light on a divine plan that disrupts the life that Mary and Joseph envisioned together.

Joseph finds himself redirected from his plan. He, like Mary, becomes an active participant in a divine project. The essence of his faith lies in the selfless and unconditional giving of himself in response to God's unfolding plan.

Joseph is familiar with the Scriptures, having heard and discussed them in the synagogue. The meditation on these prophecies reveals his direct involvement in God's promise, a promise articulated through His prophets: "The young woman, pregnant and about to bear a son, shall name him Emmanuel" (Is 7:14).

Joseph assumes an unexpected role as the father of Jesus, embracing this responsibility with love and discretion. The act of giving a name to the child signifies the assumption of paternity, a poignant moment where Joseph adopts Jesus. In this family dynamic, the carpenter teaches Jesus his trade, demonstrating the reality of Joseph taking on the role of father in all its facets.

Participating in the daily unfolding of the Incarnation, Joseph becomes the co-educator of the Son of Man. Joseph and Mary's roles initiate the child Jesus, the adolescent, and the young man into social life and manual labour. Each day, they contribute to raising Jesus until his adulthood (Luke 2:52).

As educators of Jesus, Mary and Joseph find themselves simultaneously being taught by their divine Child. Every gesture and word of Jesus resonate within their hearts, continually emphasising the importance of doing the will of the Father (Luke 8:20).

The Church, through this season, invites us to reawaken the reality of faith within us. This reawakening becomes imperative as we navigate the struggle between the grace of faith and the pull of human concerns. In contemplating the Revelation to Joseph, we find an invitation to embark on a transformative time in preparation for Christmas where, like Mary and Joseph, we actively participate in God's unfolding plan, embracing the unexpected turns with faith and hope.

# "Faith of Joseph"

Even when he is asleep, Saint Joseph is still taking care of the Church. In Joseph's resting, the will of God was revealed to him. In these moments of resting in the Lord, as we pause from our many daily obligations and activities, God is also speaking to us. But like Saint Joseph, once we have heard God's voice, we must rise from our slumber; we must get up and act.

We may be thinking that it would be easier to hear the voice of God and to focus on this holy season of Christ's birth if we could run away from the commercialism and from the demanding work deadlines and family responsibilities of Christmas time. Surely then, we could focus more on the holiness of Christmas and our spiritual interior life - or not? To give in to such a tempting thought may lead us to forget the message of the Incarnation, that God was made Man to become 'one of us' - this message reminds us that we who are followers of Jesus do not run away from the secular; rather we try to transform it by living in the world without becoming a part of the world. It is our mission as Christians to make holy the secular aspects of Christmas just as our Fathers before us made holy the land upon which Christ walked. Just as Saint Joseph was prepared to make holy the family of Jesus and Mary despite what others may have thought or presumed. How do we do this among the hustle and bustle of the season? We do this by being 'holy people' - kind, patient, generous, loving, laughing people - no matter how maddening is the Christmas rush. We do this by bringing the joy, peace and love of Christ to those in need, to those without hope, to those alone and despairing. That is what Christ did, and that's what we are called to do and to be - another Christ on earth, wherever we tread.

So, what are we doing to exemplify Christ in a world that has forgotten Him or doesn't know Him? We pray – assisted by Parish devotions such as daily/weekly Adoration and the Christmas Novena. We donate generously to those in need – either by helping with financial donations, with providing food hampers, or with a simple visit to nursing homes and hospital beds. Some of us are unable to physically or financially assist others, but our struggles and pains are also an offering that is pleasing to the Lord, when offered with love and patient endurance. God sees all. Even the smallest of sacrifices are a delight to God when offered with the same humble faith of Joseph. Each act of charity at this time is like a birthday present for the Baby Jesus. What better way to bring Christ into the world!


### **QUESTION**

من منّا لا تشبه غالبًا قصّة يوسف في مضمونها قصصًا من حياتنا؟ من منّا لا يجد نفسه أحيانًا في مواقف صعبة لم نكن لنختارها، لو قدَّر لنا أن نختار، ولا حلّ لها سوى في الله؟ من منّا لم يرزح تحت وطأةٍ ألَمِ ما في حياته، من عقمِ أو عدمِ وفاق بين الزوجين أو خيبةِ أمل من بُعدِ شبابنا عن طريق الإيمان ، أو إنحراف مراهقينا، أو إجهاضنا لجنين تلبيةً لرغبة الشربك، والأمثلة كثيرة لا تُحصى؟ في كلّ تلك الصعوبات، كلَّنا معرّضون لتجربة التخلَّى عن الله من شدّة الألم، فنصمّ آذاننا ونغلق قلوبنا على سماعه يكلَّمنا، مع العلم أنَّ لا حلَّ إِلاَّ من لدنه كما حدث مع يوسف! منذ التجسِّد لم يبقَ للظلمة من مكان في حياة الإنسان ولم يبقَ للوحدة من سبيل لأنّ الله أصبح في حضور دائمٍ معنا بروحه القدّوس. السؤال اليوم: هل هناك من "حاضرين" مستعدّين للإنفتاح على كلمة الله في العمق، فينعكس حضوره في كلّ ما يعملون ويقولون؟ هل لنا الجرأة الكافية لتخصيص وقتٍ للصراة الَّتي بها وحدها نستطيع أن نكتشف إرادة الله؟ كلِّنا مدعوُّون لاِستقبال يوسف ومريم وإبنها يسوع في بيوتنا العائليَّة، دون أن ننسى الفرح وحركة الحبّ بين الله والإنسان الَّذي، بتجسَّد إبنه في عائلةٍ بشريَّة، دعانا لمرافقته على طريق الألوهة من خلال حلوله فينا بروحه في العماد، أفلا نقبلها كما يوسف البارّ فعل؟ ما هي الأعمال التي نقوم بها في حياتنا للسماح ليسوع بالولادة في قلوبنا ونفوسنا ؟ هل نفسح في المجال أمام بيان الله ليوحي لنا بالعمل؟ لقد اتخذ الله القرار، كل ما علينا أن نفعله هو أن

ننهض ونعمل به.





أَمَّا مِيلادُ يَسُوعَ الـمَسيحِ فَكانَ هـكَذَا؛ لَمَّا كَانَتْ أَمُّهُ مَرْيَمُ مَخْطُوبَةً لِيُوسُف، وقَبْلَ أَنْ يَسْكُنَا مَعًا، وُجِدَتْ حَامِلاً مِنَ الزُّوحِ القُدْس. ولَمَّا كَانَ يُوسُفُ رَجْلُها بَازًا، ولا يُرِيدُ أَنْ يُشَهِّرَ بِهَا، قَرْزَ أَنْ يُطَلِّقَهَا سِزًا. ومَا إِنْ فَكَرْ فِي هـذَا حَقَّى تَرَاءَ ى لَهُ مَلاكُ الرَبّ في الـحُلْمِ قَائِلاً: "يَا يُوسُفُ بِنَ دَاوُد، لا تَحَفْ أَنْ تَأْخُدَ مَرْيَمَ امْرَأَتكَ، فَالـمَوْلُودُ فِيهَا إِنَّمَ هُوَ الَّذِي يُخَلِّصُ شَعْبَهُ مِنْ خَطَايَاهُم". وحَدَثَ هـذَا كُلُّهُ لِيَتِمَّ مَا قَالَهُ الرَّبْ بِالنَّبِيَ: "هَا إِنَّ العَذْرَاءَ تَدْمِلْ وَتَلِدُ ابْنَا، ويُدْعَى اسْمُهُ عِمَّانُوئِيل، أَي الله مَعَنَا". ولَمَّا قَامَ يُوسُفُ مِنَ النَّوْم، فَعَلَ كَمَا أَمْرَهُ مَلاكُ الرَبِّ وَأَخَذَ امْرَأَتَهُ. ولَمْ يَعْرِفْهَا، فَوَلَدَتِ ابْنَا، وسَمَاهُ يَسُوع. مِت ١٨١-٥٥



بعد أن بشِّر المِلاك جبرائيل مريم بأنّها، وهي عذراء، ستحبل وتلد إبن الله المتجسّد، تراءى في الحلم ليوسف، وكشف له سرّ حبل مريم، ودوره كأب شرعيّ لإبنها الإلهيّ، في الوقت الّذي كان يوسف يفكّر بتخلية مريم سرًّا من دون العودة إلى القضاء. لكنّه أصغى في تلك اللّيلة لصوت اللّه: "يا يوسف إبن داود، لا تخف أن تأخذ مريم امرأتك. فالمولود فيها إنّما هو من الروح القدس، وسوف تلد إبنًا، فسمّه يسوع، لأنّه هو الّذي يخلّص شعبه من خطاياهم" (متَّى ان ٢٠ ـ ١٦).

يعلّمنا البيان كيف يمكننا أن نتمّم قرارات الله عبر إلهامات الروح القدس. في كثير من الحالات، يكشف لنا الله ما يريده منا عبر إشارات أو أشخاص أو لحظات عميقة من الصلاة.

عن طريق إلهامات الروح القدس، فَهِم يوسف ما كان يُطلب منه فنهض في الصباح التالي وفعل ذلك تماماً. لم يسأل، لم يفكر أو يؤجّل. نهض فوراً وتصرّف بـِصمته، أنجز عملاً عظيماً متمّماً قرارات الله. عمله جاء من حسٍّ بالثقة، وحسٍّ بالرضى والأمان، ومن إيمانه الكبير. فكانت كلمة الله الحيّة نورًا أضاءت أعمق ما في قلبه وفتحته على حياة جديدةٍ وطريقٍ جديد، جعلته يستقبل هذا الحبِّ الفائض في حياته ليتبنّاه ويكون أبًا له في التاريخ.
