We are deep into the Season of Pentecost with Gospel passages focusing mission. Today we hear of the sending out of Jesus' followers to be active ministers in the world at large.

Jesus appoints 70 others and sends them out ahead of him. We also know Jesus had chosen 12 others to be around him. We read that, 'the harvest is plentiful, but the labourers are few; therefore ask the Lord of the harvest to send out labours into his harvest'_{v2}. We can never have too many ministers! Christ is always on the lookout for more people to be part of this mission.

So do we feel the calling to be representatives of Christ to others? The understanding here is that:

- 1. Christ wants our help
- 2. We are called to work together
- 3. There is much to do.

The 70 are to take no purse, bag or sandal_{v4}. When we go on behalf of Christ, we go with God's grace. What matters is our willingness, not our credentials.

Finally Jesus says as you enter a house your first words must be, 'Peace to this house' v5. That is our mission, to be messengers of peace. And if that is the case, we can never have too many labourers in the harvest! Amen

Saint María Goretti



Born in Corinaldo, Ancona, Italy, on October 16 1890. Her father died of malaria and her mother had to struggle to feed her children.

In 1902 an eighteen-year-old neighbour, Alexander, grabbed her from her steps and tried to rape her. When Maria said that she would rather die than submit. Alexander began stabbing her with a knife.

As she lay in the hospital, she forgave Alexander before she died. Her death didn't end her forgiveness, however.

Alexander was captured and sentenced to thirty years. He was unrepentant until he had a dream that he was in a garden. Maria was there and gave him flowers. When he woke, he was a changed man, repenting of his crime and living a reformed life. When he was released after 27 years he went directly to Maria's mother to beg her forgiveness, which she gave. "If my daughter can forgive him, who am I to withhold forgiveness," she said.

When Maria was declared a saint in 1950, Alexander was there in the St. Peter's crowd to celebrate her canonization. She was canonized by Pope Pius XII in 1950 for her purity as model for youth.

She is called a martyr because she fought against Alexander's attempts at sexual assault. However, the most important aspect of her story is her forgiveness of her attacker -- her concern for her enemy extending even beyond death. Her feast day is July 6. St. Maria Goretti is the patroness of youth and for the victims of rape.

Article of the Week - A Word from His Holiness Pope Francis



In his most recent Wed Audience address, the Holy Father Pope Francis spoke about the wounding and in particular the wounds we inflict on one another in the family. The Holy Father bluntly describes this as being "the worst thing". He builds on this because of the direct affect these wounds have on the most vulnerable members of our families, our children.

Pope Francis says:

"In the family, everything is connected: when her soul is wounded in some way, the infection spreads to everyone. And when a man and a woman, who have committed to being "one flesh" and forming a family, think

obsessively of their own need for freedom and gratification, this bias affects the hearts and lives of their children in a profound way. Frequently these children hide to cry alone.... We need to understand this fully. Husband and wife are one flesh. Their own little children are flesh of their flesh. If we think of the harshness with which Jesus admonishes adults not to scandalize the little ones — we heard the Gospel passage (cf. Mt 18:6) — we can also better understand his words on the serious responsibility to guard the marital bond that gives rise to the human family (cf. Mt 19:6-9). When man and woman have become one flesh, all the father and mother's wounds and neglect have an impact on the living flesh of their children."

For those of us blessed with the gift of being parents we must take care. Regardless of the reasons or causes, we must always proceed with caution when our children are around. Our actions have the potential to cause them great pain and suffering (as pointed out by the Pope). In saying this however we must not shy away from the fact that our actions can also bring great love, joy and peace to our little ones. Aiming to always nurture the marital bond with prayer is a great remedy to help calm the negative emotions and feelings that can come in times on anger. "Let us ask the Lord for great faith, in order to see reality through the eyes of God; and for great charity in order to approach people with his merciful heart."

طالما أنَّ روح الانجيل، بتعليمه وقيمه وروحانيّته، لم يدخل أعماق كلّ إنسان، ستظلّ النزاعات والاضطهادات والاعتداءات والحروب متواصلة وعلى اشتداد، كما نرى عندنا في بيئتنا المشرقيّة، حتى إنها تصل إلى صُلب العائلة، إلى تمرّد الأبناء على الآباء وقتلهم، وإلى النزاع القاتل بين الأخوة. وتصل أيضًا إلى اضطهاد المؤمنين بالمسيح فقط لأنّهم مسيحيّون. أساس كلّ هذه الأمور إنّما هو جهل السماويات. عندما هتف الشهداء بإيمانهم بالمسيح تحت مقارع المضطهدين، فُتح أمامهم الطريق للإيمان

قال أحد الآباء الروحيّين: "إذا قارنتَ الإنسان بالأفعى، تجده أسوأ منها.فالأفعى حالما تكون مُهدّدة، تصبح مُهلِكة. لكن إذا لم تُهدَّد، تنسلّ مبتعدة. أما الناس فإنّهم، ولو كانوا غير مُهدَّدين، يثورون غضبًا، ويتهيّجون على الذين لم يهدّدوهم. وخلاصة القول إنَّ في كلّ حيوان متوحّش أذىً خاصًا به، أما الإنسان فإنّه مستودع كلّ الشرور".

أ- يدعوهم للثبات في الصبر لضمانة الانتصار: "مَن يثبت إلى المنتهى يخلص"(متى 10:22). يقول هذا، لأنّ البادئين عادة كثيرون، والمنتهين قلّة. يقولالقديس يوحنا فم الذهب: "هناك دائمًا متعةٌ في البدء، لكنّ التمحّص هو في النهاية. فما من أحد يستطيع أن يثبت مع الله حتى النهاية من دون أن يكون منتميًا إليه عن طريق النعمة. العظمة لا تكون في بدء شيء صالح، بل في بلوغ النهاية بلوغًا صالحًا. إنّ جوهر الحياة الصالحة هو الموت الصالح. غالبًا ما تبدأ الرغبة الجسدية بشيء صالح، لكنّها لا تبلغ النهاية إلا بنعمة الله".

ب- ويشير عليهم بالهروب من المكان حيث يُضطهدون إلى مكان آخر، لمواصلة رسالتهم، هذا ليس خنوعًا، بل فطنة. يقول المثل: "العين لا تُقاوم المخرز"، ومثل آخر: "القصبة لا تقاوم الريح".

"القرب يجعل من الكنيسة جماعة حقيقية"



"على المسيحيين أن يقتربوا ويمدوا يدهم الى كل من يرفضهم المجتمع كما فعل يسوع مع المهمشين وهذا ما يجعل من الكنيسة "جماعة حقيقية". انطلق البابا من إنجيل القديس متى (8: 1-4) عندما تشجع أبرص ودنا من يسوع وقال: "يا رب، إن شئت فأنت قادر أن تبرئني" فمد يسوع يده فلمسه وقال: "قد شئتُ فابرأ". من هنا علّم يسوع الكنيسة بأنها لا يمكنها أن تكون جماعة من دون أن تكون قريبة من الآخرين.

لا يُصنع الخير من بعيد

حصلت المعجزة تحت نظر علماء الشريعة الذين كانوا يعتبرون الأبرص بأنه "غير طاهر" "كانوا يعتبرون الأبرص بأنه محكوم عليه حتى الموت بهذه الحالة وكان شفاء الأبرص أمرًا صعبًا جدًا أشبه بإقامة أحد من الموت. إنما يسوع مدّ يده لمن هو

بسوع بضمّ

عندما شفى يسوع الأبرص طلب منه أن يذهب ليري نفسه للكاهن: "إياك أن تخبر أحدًا، بل اذهب الى الكاهن فأره نفسك، ثمّ قرّب ما أمر به موسى من قربان، شهادة لديهم". وهذا كله لأنّ يسوع يحبّ الانخراط أيضًا. إنّ من رفضه المجتمع وهمّشه أراد يسوع أن يعيد ضمّه الى الجماعة: هو يجمع في المجتمع من المجتمع لا يهمّش أحدًا، أبدًا! بل هو يهمّش ذاته ليعيد ضمّنا، نحن الخطأة والمهمّشن الى حياته". القرب يعنى أن نمد يدنا

سلّط الضوء البابا على الذهول الذي خلقه يسوع بين الشعب عندما قام بهذا العمل "كم من الناس كانوا يتبعون يسوع لأنهم ذُهلوا بكلامه؟ وكم من الناس كانوا يراقبونه من بعيد ولا يفهمون شيئًا؟ حتى كم من الناس أيضًا كانوا ينظرون من بعيد ويحاولون أن ينتقدوا يسوع وأن يدينوه لأنهم لم يملكوا شجاعته؟ وفي كل ذلك، كان يسوع يمدّ يده هو أولاً وليس في هذه الحالة فحسب بل دائمًا وأصبح شخصًا مثلنا شابهنا بكل شيء ما عدا الخطيئة بل حمل خطيئتنا وهذا هو القرب المسيحي!" "القرب هو كلمة جميلة! ولكن أدعوكم أن نقوموا بفحص ضمير: "هل أنا أقترب من الناس؟" هل أملك القوة وأتحلى بالشجاعة لكي أمدّ يدي الى المهمّشين؟ إنه سؤال أتوجّه به الى الكنيسة والرعايا والجماعات والمكرسين والأساقفة والكهنة والجميع".


