

THE GOSPEL

One of the Pharisees asked Jesus to eat with him, and he went into the Pharisee's house and took his place at the table. And a woman in the city, who was a sinner, having learned that he was eating in the Pharisee's house, brought an alabaster jar of ointment. She stood behind him at his feet, weeping, and began to bathe his feet with her tears and to dry them with her hair. Then she continued kissing his feet and anointing them with the ointment. Now when the Pharisee who had invited him saw it, he said to himself, "If this man were a prophet, he would have known who and what kind of woman this is who is touching him - that she is a sinner." Jesus spoke up and said to him, "Simon, I have something to say to you." "Teacher," he replied, "Speak." "A certain creditor had two debtors; one owed five hundred denarii, and the other fifty. When they could not pay, he cancelled the debts for both of them. Now which of them will love him more?" Simon answered, "I suppose the one for whom he cancelled the greater debt." And Jesus said to him, "You have judged rightly." Then turning toward the woman, he said to Simon, "Do you see this woman? I entered your house; you gave me no water for my feet, but she has bathed my feet with her tears and dried them with her hair. You gave me no kiss, but from the time I came in she has not stopped kissing my feet. You did not anoint my head with oil, but she has anointed my feet with ointment. Therefore, I tell you, her sins, which were many, have been forgiven; hence she has shown great love. But the one to whom little is forgiven, loves little." Then he said to her, "Your sins are forgiven." But those who were at the table with him began to say among themselves, "Who is this who even forgives sins?" And he said to the woman, "Your faith has saved you; go in peace."

Brothers and sisters, Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace to you and peace. THE SERVANTS WORD

The merciful Lord with the repentant woman and prejudice

Dear brothers and sisters,

On the fifteenth Sunday of the Season of Pentecost, we reflect on Saint Luke's Gospel about the sinful woman who came to the Lord, crying for her sin and proclaiming her repentance at his feet. With her unique boldness, she was able to overcome the eyes of a cruel society, the gossip of the malicious, the whispers of the chatters, the hearsay of the fawners, and the judgments of prominent people who think of themselves as better than others while they are whitewashed tombs.

her audacity, faith and love. The Lord saw her great love, so he forgave her many sins. She only asked for his mercy, with tears of fountain of love, overflowed her with greater love. He did not treat her on the basis of the law or social traditions, as the Pharisee and his companions did. He did not look at her as someone inferior, as the one who invited him did, but according to her human dignity. On the basis of this dignity, he treated her. And because of his great mercy and love, the Lord sought to repentant deserves forgiveness and love so they may begin a and salvation. new life worthy of Jesus Christ the forgiving Saviour.

The story of the repentant woman teaches us that our peace and salvation can only come from Jesus Christ, because if it was up to the human, that woman would have been humiliated and offended even more. With the Lord Jesus however, his words challenge the society's view of her. She was able to walk out from Stay tuned. underneath the rubble of sin, the ashes of the bad reputation and the injustice of people, washing his feet with the most precious things she had: her tears, ointment and hair, the symbol of her dignity and honour. And the Lord restored her honour and dignity by honouring her above all the audience and dignifying her with his love and mercy.

.We too, the Lord honours us and fills us with his mercy when we have the courage to repent, because we are "God's beloved", as Saint Paul describes us in his Second Letter to the Thessalonians. Since we are God's beloved people, he chose us and saved us with free grace. We only need to live our faith with love. But the question is: do we have today the courage of the sinful woman to reach our goal, which is the Lord Jesus, to prostrate at his feet, That woman was weak because of her sin, but magnificent with putting before him our sins and tears of repentance, in order to recover our dignity, live our peace and set out with his peace? Or are we like the Pharisees, looking down on others, pointing to repentance, seeking it with love. A SHOW OF LOVE

Our Sunday Gospel passage focuses on a woman who enters a house uninvited but provides great hospitality. Last week's Gospel gave us Martha's story of her invitation to Jesus to enter her home. This week we have Simon, a Pharisee, invite Jesus.

The theme of welcoming Jesus and hospitality continues on. We will focus this week on the actions of the uninvited woman.

She bathes Jesus' feet with her tears and dries them with her hair. It sounds odd to us today but let us try and see beyond the external actions. The woman, in the presence of all, sheds tears. She is comfortable enough before Jesus to expose her raw emotions. She is the one who feels welcomed in his presence and the one who seeks and draws near with an open heart and with transparency.

The woman kisses Jesus' feet. She has no shame before others. In Jesus' presence she shows great love. Her actions reveal great hospitality. She yearns for Jesus' presence and lovingly seeks him out.

Finally, she anoints Jesus' feet with oil. Her actions are tender and soothing. She caresses, she loves, she attends to the guest.

The woman, who is called a sinner, teaches us, sinners too, that no matter our past, our grievances, our troubles, we can and should always find time for Jesus in our lives. We are invited into a tender loving relationship with the God who lavishly returns the love. Amen

MESSAGE FROM THE BISHOP


Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The Maronite Church celebrates on the 30th of August the feast of Blessed Estephan Nehme, born Youssef Nehme in Lehfed, Jbeil on 8 March 1889. He was the youngest boy in a family of six children. He lost both his parents at a young age. In 1905, he entered the Lebanese Maronite Order monastery of Saints Cyprian and Justina, Kfifan as a novice taking the name Estephan.

On 23 August 1907, he pronounced his vows of obedience, chastity and poverty, and became a religious members of the Lebanese Maronite Order. He chose to remain a brother and did not become a priest. He worked the fields of many monasteries where he was appointed and was known for being a peaceful man with a strong build and a joyful nature. He was also known for repeating the words: "God sees me." Living his life in this simple way, Brother Estephan Nehme showed us that sanctity is attainable and that one can become a saint by digging orchards and rendering acts of service to his neighbour.

Living our life aware of God's presence, we can sanctify our lives with simple acts of love that do not appear spectacular from the outside, but are actually heroic in value. Brother Estephan did not become a hermit, like Charbel, nor teach, like St Nehmetallah, nor endure extraordinary suffering, like St Rafqa. But in the evening, after returning from a long day in the fields, instead of resting, he visited the elderly monks in his convent and offered them his services and keeping them company. He died at the age of 49, on August 30, 1939. The day of his entry into eternal joy now marks his feast day.

Friends, on this Sunday let us seek the intercession of Blessed Estephan for our world and for our nation Australia. Our Maronite community is suffering and is under huge financial, emotional and social pressure.



Coupled with fear, the despair amongst many is heightened and has manifested itself in deep anxiety, stress and sometimes even irrational thoughts. We are deeply saddened that the Churches are not open. Now, more than ever, we need to remember that God is present in our world. He is with us in our difficulties and waiting for us to feel His presence and closeness.

Blessed Estephan says "love does not need any education or science, it just comes out of the heart." Now, more than ever, we can demonstrate we are Christians by our love. We can make small sacrifices to make sure that our neighbours and the most vulnerable are kept safe. We must speak up for the marginalised and those who are suffering. Now we can seize the opportunity and take the message of Christ to Australia in simple acts of love, sacrifice and service.

I wish you a Blessed Sunday and a very blessed feast day to all!



في الأحد الخامس عشر من زمن العنصرة، نتأمل بإنجيل القديس لوقا عن المرأة الخاطئة التي أتت تبكي خطيئتها وتعلن توبتها عند قدمَيْ يسوع، متخطيةً بجرأتها الفريدة عيون المجتمع القاسي، وأقاويل المغرضين، وهمسات الثرثارين، وألسنة المتزلفين، وأحكام أصحاب الوجاهة الذين يظنون أنفسهم أفضل من سواهم فيما هم قبور مكلّسة.

ضعيفة هي تلك المرأة بخطيئتها، لكنها جبارة بجرأتها وإيمانها وحبها. لمس الرب حبها الكبير فغفر لها الكثير، لم تطلب سوى رحمته، طلبتها بدموع التوبة، جدّت وراءها بحب، فأفاض عليها نبعُ الحب، الرب يسوع، حباً أكبر، لم يعاملها الرب على أساس الشريعة أو تقاليد المجتمع كما فعل الفريسي وأصحابه. لم ينظر إليها بدونية كما فعل صاحب الدعوة، بل وفق كرامتها الإنسانية، وعلى أساس هذه الكرامة عاملها، ولشدة رحمته وحبه، سعى الرب ليفهم الفريسي والحضور الثرثار أن الخاطئ التائب يستحق الغفور،

قصة المرأة التائبة تعلّمنا أن سلامنا وخلاصنا لا يأتيان إلا من يسوع المسيح، لأنه لو تُرك الأمر للإنسان لكانت تلك المرأة ذُلّت وأهينت أكثر. أما مع الرب يسوع، فإن كلامه غيّرها وأعطاها شجاعة كبيرة مكّنها من تحدي نظرة المجتمع إليها، فخرجت من تحت ركام الخطيئة، ورماد الصيت السيء، وظلم الناس، لتفسل قدميه بأثمن ما عندها، دموعها وطيبها وشعرها، رمز كرامتها وشرفها، فرد لها الرب شرفها وكرامتها بأن شرّفها فوق جميع الحضور وكرّمها بحبه ورحمته.

هكذا نحن أيضاً، يكرمنا الرب ويغمرنا برحمته عندما تكون لدينا شجاعة التوبة، لأننا "أحباء الله" كما يصفنا القديس بولس في رسالته الثانية إلى أهل تسالونيكي. ولأننا أحباء الله، فقد اختارنا وخلصنا بنعمة مجانية، وما علينا سوى أن نعيش إيماننا بحب ومجانية. لكن السؤال هو: هل لدينا اليوم جرأة المرأة الخاطئة لنصل إلى هدفنا وهو الرب يسوع، فنسجد عند قدميه، واضعين أمامه خطايانا ودموع توبتنا لكي نسترد كرامتنا ونعيش سلامنا وننطلق بسلامه؟ أم أننا مثل الفريسيين، ننظر إلى الآخرين بدونية، ندل عليهم بإصبع الاتهام، ونحرمهم من نعمة الغفران والرحمة والحب، ونحرم أنفسنا من الخلاص؟
